Due diligence processes for slavery and human trafficking

- Encourage our staff to report any breach of this policy.
- Protect staff that have brought issues to our attention.

Supplier adherence to our values

We have zero tolerance to slavery and human trafficking and are committed as a business to tackling modern slavery and human trafficking, to this end we want to work with suppliers who share our values.

Training

All employees are required to familiarise our slavery and human trafficking policy as part of their employment conditions, this being reviewed annually in training.
